New Guidance for Expanded Personal Services

Tentative implementation date of June 19, 2020 with Health Officer Approval

San Benito County, California June 12, 2020: Expanded personal services guidance has been released today by the State of California.

The following guidance has been released for <u>expanded personal services</u>, which includes personal care that requires touching a client's face, e.g. facials, electrolysis, and waxing. This guidance also applies to esthetician, skin care, and cosmetology services; electrology; nail salons; body art professionals, tattoo parlors, and piercing shops; and massage therapy (in non-healthcare settings).

It is imperative to be advised that the County Public Health Officer must approve the industries to open prior to implementation. The date of implementation will be no sooner than June 19, 2020.
