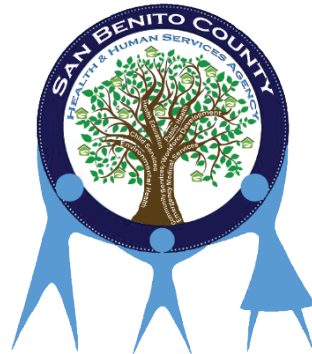

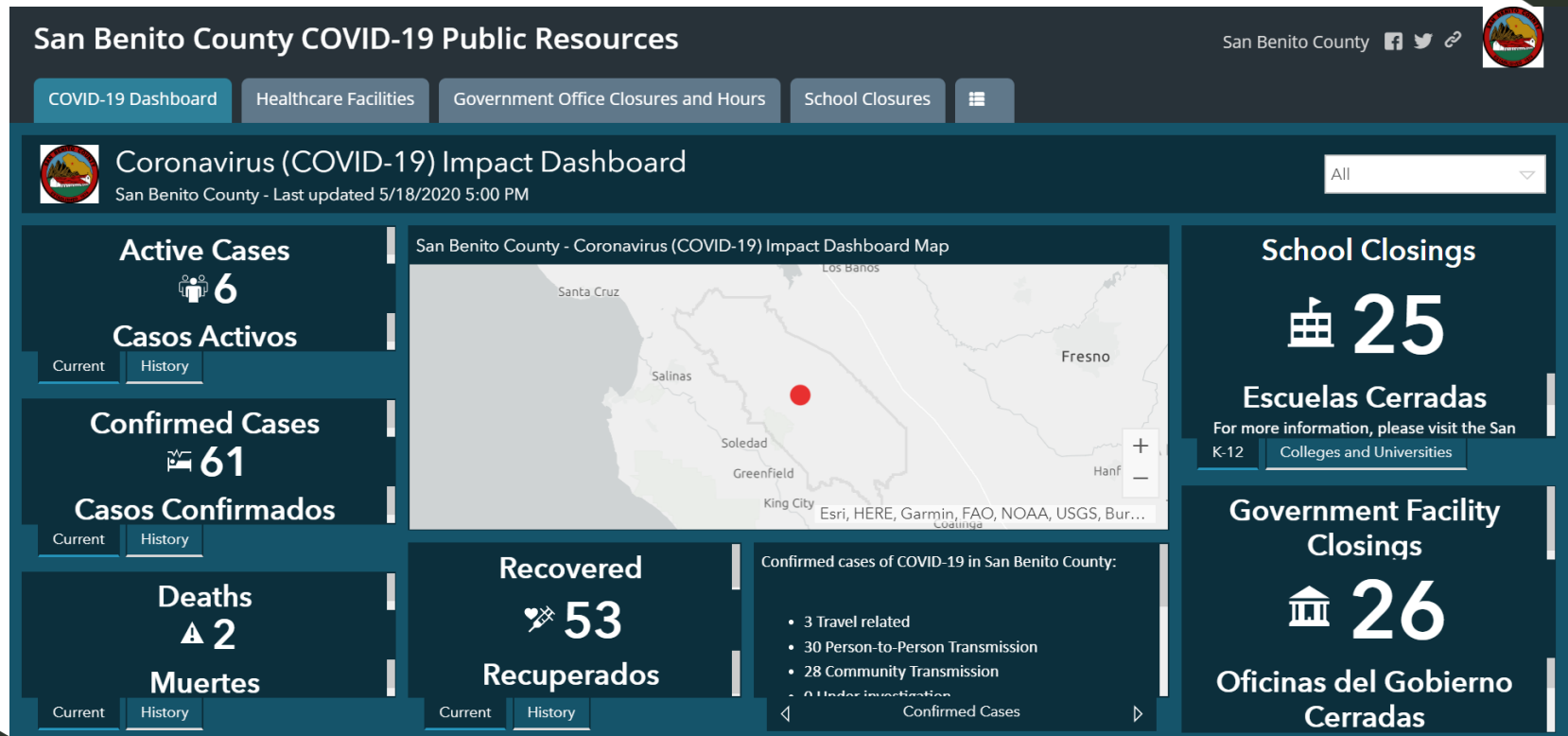

COVID-19

Stage 2 and Expanded Stage 2

May 12, 2020 -Early Stage 2:

- Curb-side Retail
- Manufacturers
- Logistics
- Childcare for those outside of the essential workforce
- Office-based businesses (telework remains strongly encouraged)
- Select services: car washes, pet grooming, and landscape gardening
- Outdoor museums, and open gallery spaces and other public spaces with modifications

May 13, 2020- Expanded Stage 2 with Attestation posted to CDPH website:

- Destination retail (***retail stores***), including shopping malls and swap meets
- Dine-in restaurants
- Schools with modifications

San Benito County Recommendations:

- Follow guidance for related industry
- Post a copy of the completed guidance checklist at your business
- Self Certify and post that you have completed the checklist and you are following the guidance for your business
- Should the guidance not be followed, the County is at risk of a possible surge and will need to assess the need for a county specific Shelter in Place order.
- The Health Officer continues to monitor the need for the face covering order.

COVID-19 Governor's Update

- On May 18, 2020, Governor Newsom noted that 24 counties to date have filed local variance attestations. The Governor encouraged members of the public to visit the [COVID-19 website](#) to track their county data online.
- The Governor stated that they have been tracking the number of hospitalizations as well as those in ICU's over the past fourteen days. They have seen a 7.5% decline in the number of hospitalizations along with an 8.7% decline of the number of people in ICUs. This stabilization, along with securing a strong supply of PPE, substantially expanding testing capacity, and expanding California's contact tracing workforce, allows the state to provide additional modifications to allow larger counties to begin to also make further progress into the second phase of reopening.
- If rates continue to remain steady, the Governor announced he hoped he would be making statements in the next few weeks, on a statewide basis, to allow for in-store retail with modifications, sporting events without spectators, and potentially haircuts as well.

Governor's Update

- New guidelines will be forthcoming for the faith based community. The Governor noted that they've made some modifications to guidelines to allow for faith-based counseling and for faith-based workforce to resume operations such as an office would, with modifications; however, there still is no allowance for congregations to reconvene in person.

- ♦Live alone or with 1 other eligible adult
- ♦Do not have a current support system
- ♦Annual income does not exceed \$74,940 (single) or \$101,460 (2-person)
