COVID-19 UPDATE: JUNE 29, 2020 Epidemiologic Week 27: 6/28/2020 - 7/4/2020

To date, a total of 5,084 patients in San Benito County (SBC) have been tested for COVID-19 at thirty reporting laboratories. Of these, 4,844 have tested negative for COVID-19. Fifty-seven percent (2,855) of patients tested were female. Patients ages ranged from 5 days to 101 years (median: 47 years). SBC Public Health Services continues to work with medical providers to identify and test individuals who meet criteria for COVID-19 testing. As of June 29, 2020, seven new cases have been reported, for a total of 213 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in SBC. Confirmed cases include patients who have since recovered and those who are deceased. Twenty-two cases remain active; 189 patients have recovered and are no longer considered active cases in SBC. A total of two deaths have been reported in SBC, one during weeks 12 and 14, respectively. All results included in this update are current to June 29, 2020 at 2:30PM.

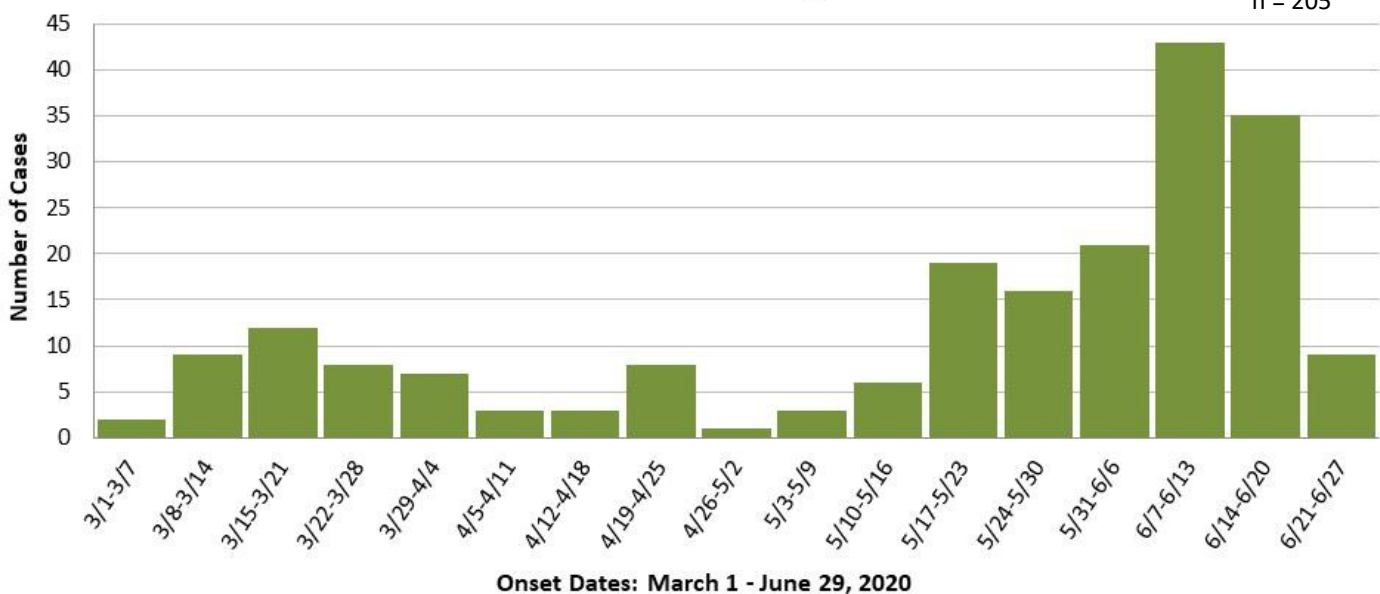

Confirmed COVID-19 Cases by Onset Date in SBC

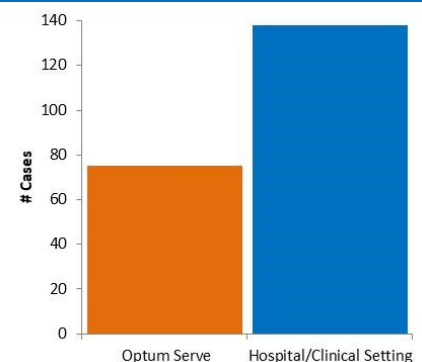

Testing Site of Confirmed COVID-19 Cases



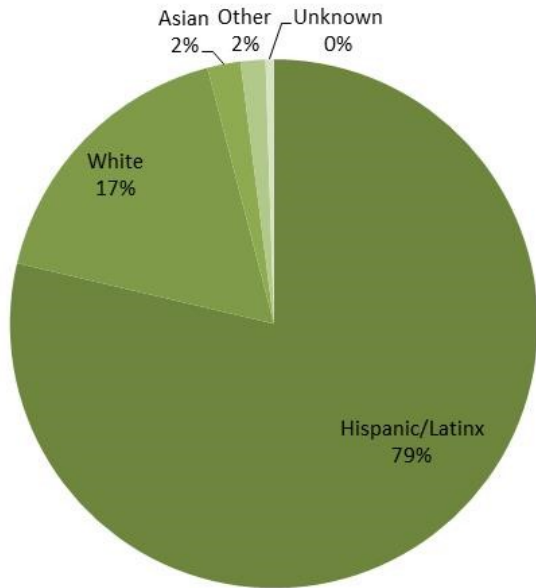

Race/Ethnicity Among COVID-19 Cases in SBC

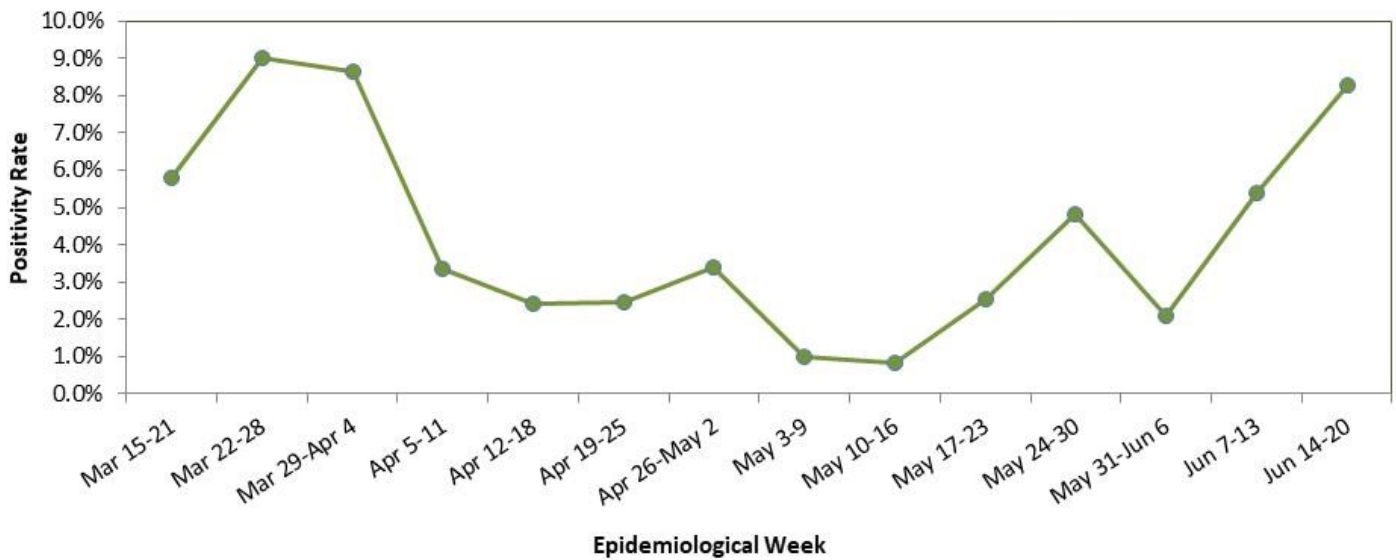

Community transmission (also referred to as community spread or community acquired transmission) occurs when the source of infection is unknown. Person-to-person transmission (also referred to as contact transmission) occurs when infection is spread through a lab-confirmed contact. Person-to-person transmission typically occurs in close-contact environments, such as households or workplaces. Onset date refers to the onset date of symptoms or test date. In SBC, 37% of positive cases work in neighboring counties including: Santa Clara (62%), Monterey (14%) and Santa Cruz (10%).
