COVID-19 UPDATE: AUGUST 10, 2020 Epidemiologic Week 33: 8/9/2020 - 8/15/2020

To date, a total of 9,421 patients in San Benito County (SBC) have been tested for COVID-19. Of these, 8,629 have tested negative for COVID-19. Fifty-five percent (5,185) of patients tested were female. Patients ages ranged from 5 days to 101 years (median: 43 years). SBC Public Health Services continues to work with medical providers to identify and test individuals who meet criteria for COVID-19 testing. As of August 10, 2020, forty-seven new cases have been reported, for a total of 765 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in SBC. Confirmed cases include patients who have since recovered and those who are deceased. Eighty-two cases remain active; 679 patients have recovered and are no longer considered active cases in SBC. A total of four deaths have been reported in SBC, one during weeks 12 and 14, and two during week 31, respectively. All results included in this update are current to August 10, 2020 at 4:00PM.

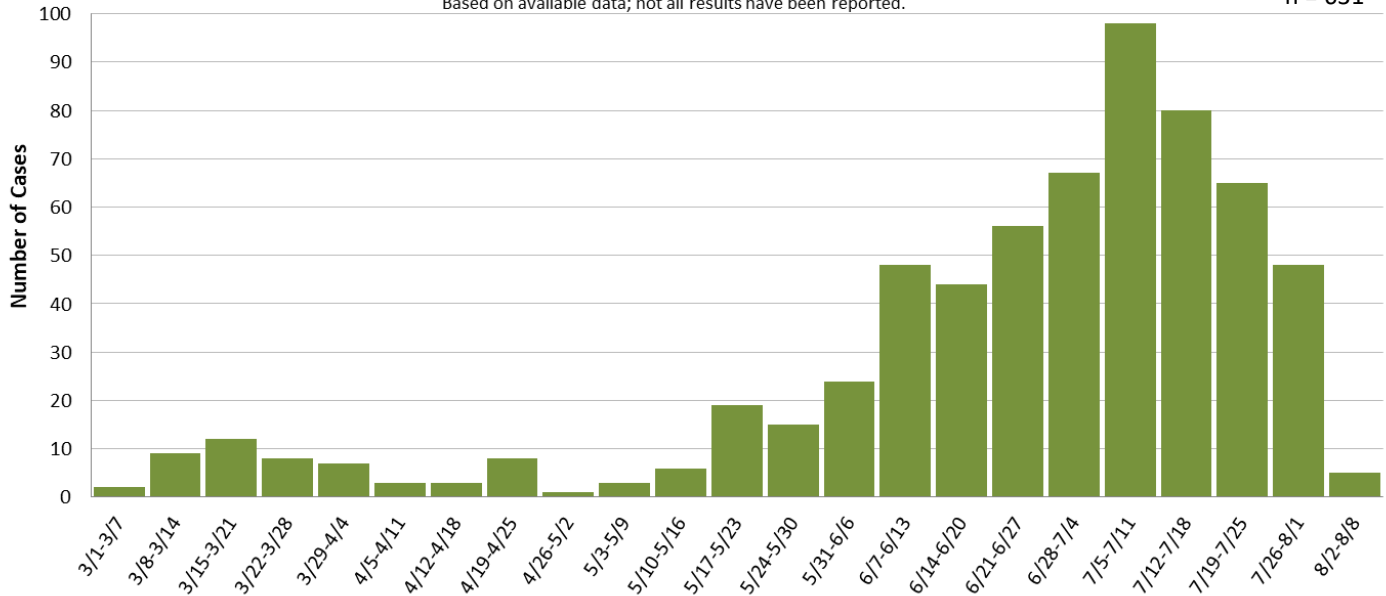

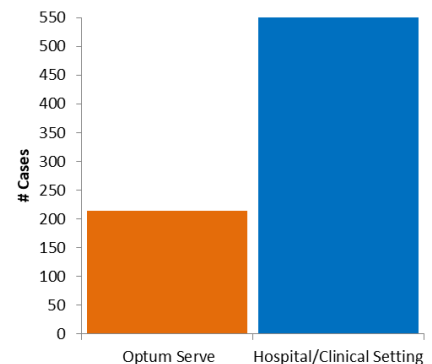

Testing Site of Confirmed COVID-19 Cases



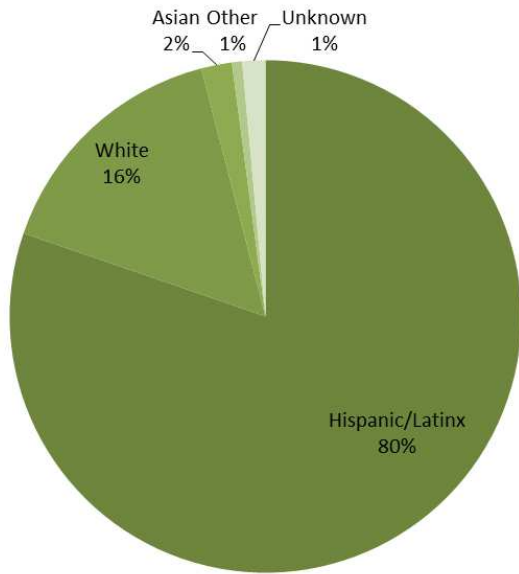

Race/Ethnicity Among COVID-19 Cases in SBC

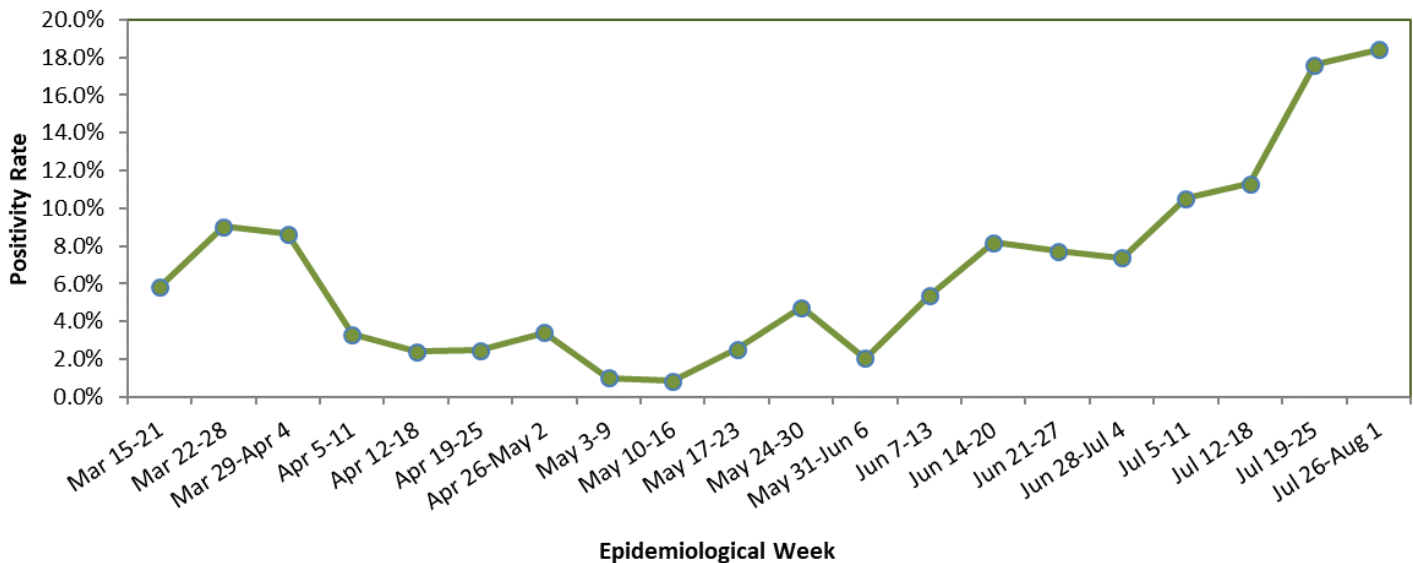

Community transmission (also referred to as community spread or community acquired transmission) occurs when the source of infection is unknown. Person-to-person transmission (also referred to as contact transmission) occurs when infection is spread through a lab-confirmed contact. Person-to-person transmission typically occurs in close-contact environments, such as households or workplaces. Onset date refers to the onset date of symptoms or test date.
