

San Benito County Public Health Services COVID-19 UPDATE: SEPTEMBER 29, 2020 Epidemiologic Week 40: 9/27/2020 - 10/3/2020




This report is based on only available data; not all results have been received.

San Benito County (SBC) Public Health Services continues to work with medical providers to identify and test individuals who meet criteria for COVID-19 testing. As of September 29, 2020, no new cases have been reported, for a total of 1,348 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in SBC. Confirmed cases include patients who have since recovered and those who are deceased. Fifty-three percent (711) of positive cases reported were female; ages ranged from 2 months to 101 years (median: 36 years).

All results included in this update are current to September 29, 2020 at 3:30PM.


Onset of Symptoms


