## COVID-19 UPDATE: SEPTEMBER 2, 2020

Epidemiologic Week 36: 8/30/2020 - 9/5/2020

To date, a total of 12,553 patients in San Benito County (SBC) have been tested for COVID-19. Of these, 11,403 have tested negative for COVID-19. SBC Public Health Services continues to work with medical providers to identify and test individuals who meet criteria for COVID-19 testing. As of September 2, 2020, eleven new cases have been reported, for a total of 1,123 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in SBC. Confirmed cases include patients who have since recovered and those who are deceased. Ninety-nine cases remain active; 1,016 patients have recovered and are no longer considered active cases in SBC. A total of eight deaths have been reported in SBC to date. Fifty-three percent (594) of positive cases reported were female. Cases ages ranged from 2 months to 89 years (median: 36 years). All results included in this update are current to September 2, 2020 at 3:30PM.

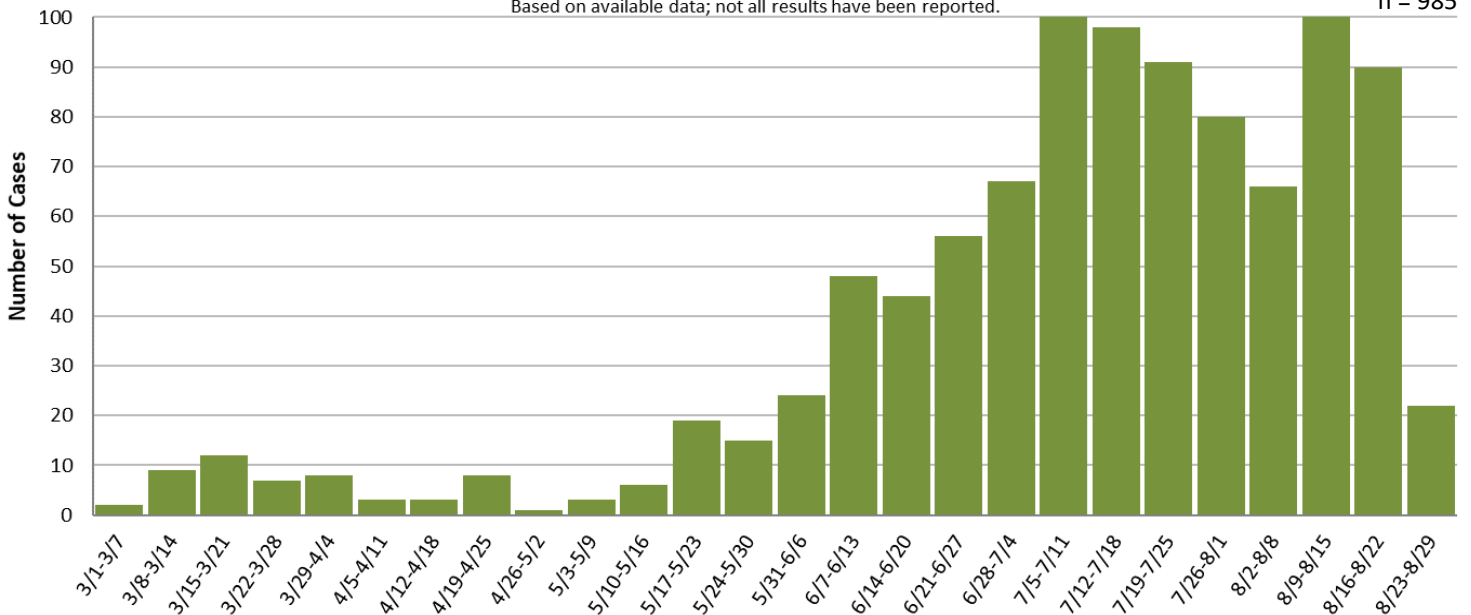

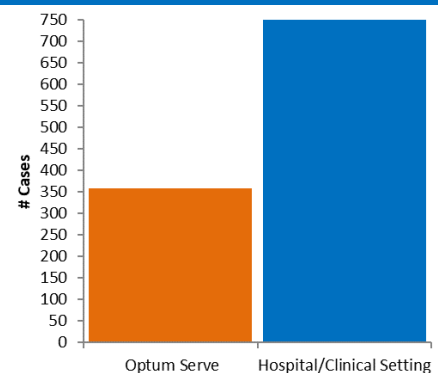

### Testing Site of Confirmed COVID-19 Cases



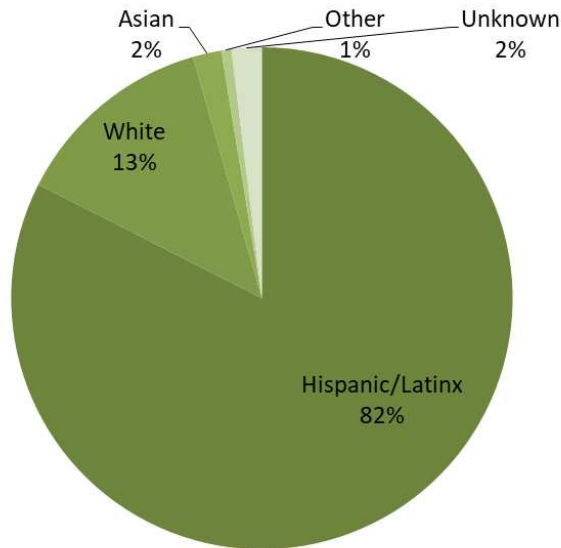

**Race/Ethnicity Among COVID-19 Cases in SBC**



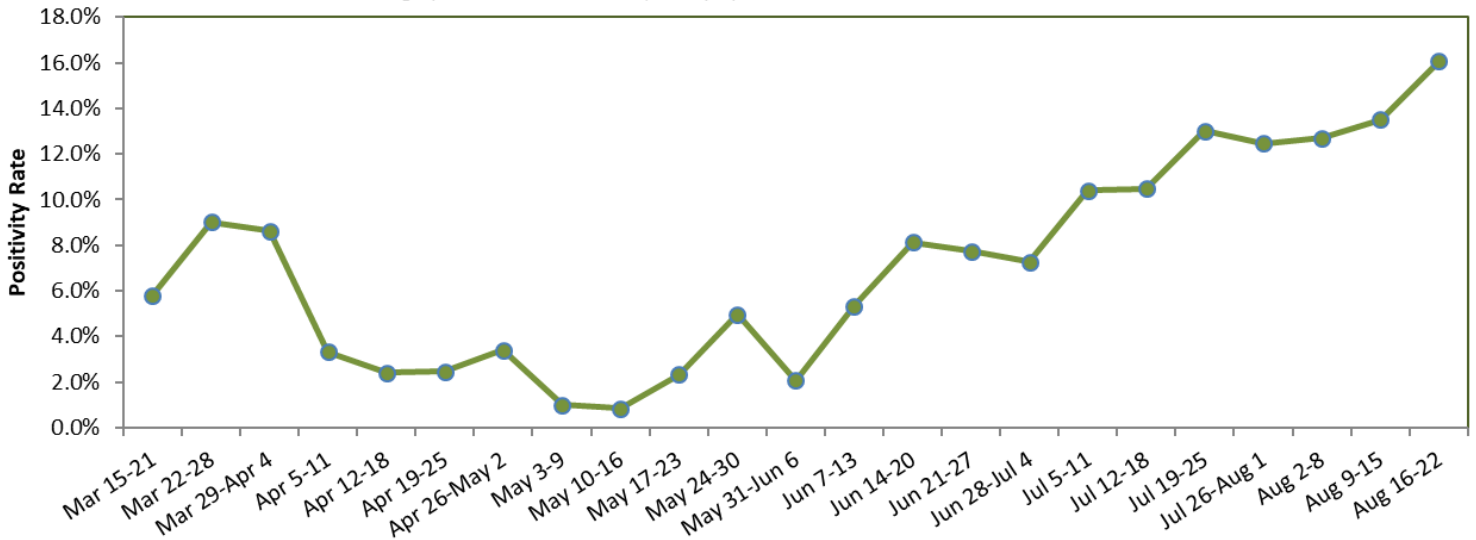

Community transmission (also referred to as community spread or community acquired transmission) occurs when the source of infection is unknown. Person-to-person transmission (also referred to as contact transmission) occurs when infection is spread through a lab-confirmed contact. Person-to-person transmission typically occurs in close-contact environments, such as households or workplaces. Onset date refers to the onset date of symptoms or test date.
