
San Benito County (SBC) Public Health Services continues to work with medical providers to identify and test individuals who meet criteria for COVID-19 testing. As of October 5, 2020, two new cases have been reported, for a total of 1,367 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in SBC. Confirmed cases include patients who have since recovered and those who are deceased. Fifty-three percent (719) of positive cases reported were female; ages ranged from 2 months to 101 years (median: 36 years).

All results included in this update are current to October 5, 2020 at 3:30PM.



Community transmission occurs when the source of infection is unknown. Person-to-person transmission occurs when infection is spread through a confirmed contact. Person-to-person transmission typically occurs in close-contact environments, such as households or workplaces.

Cases in SBC by Race/Ethnicity[±]




