

San Benito County Public Health Services COVID-19 UPDATE: OCTOBER 6, 2020 Epidemiologic Week 41: 10/4/2020 - 10/10/2020



This report is based on only available data; not all results have been received.

San Benito County (SBC) Public Health Services continues to work with medical providers to identify and test individuals who meet criteria for COVID-19 testing. As of October 6, 2020, four new cases have been reported, for a total of 1,371 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in SBC. Confirmed cases include patients who have since recovered and those who are deceased. Fifty-three percent (720) of positive cases reported were female; ages ranged from 2 months to 101 years (median: 36 years).



Cases in SBC by Race/Ethnicity⁴



Community transmission occurs when the source of infection is unknown. Person-to-person transmission occurs when infection is spread through a confirmed contact. Person-to-person transmission typically occurs in close-contact environments, such as households or workplaces.

SBC COVID-19 Cases by Age Group




