

## San Benito County Public Health Services COVID-19 UPDATE: OCTOBER 14, 2020 Epidemiologic Week 42: 10/11/2020 - 10/17/2020


San Benito County (SBC) Public Health Services continues to work with medical providers to identify and test individuals who meet criteria for COVID-19 testing. As of October 14, 2020, two new cases have been reported, for a total of 1,390 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in SBC. Confirmed cases include patients who have since recovered and those who are deceased. Fifty-three percent (733) of positive cases reported were female; ages ranged from 2 months to 101 years (median: 36 years).

All results included in this update are current to October 14, 2020 at 3:00PM.

Onset of Symptoms


