

San Benito County Public Health Services COVID-19 UPDATE: NOVEMBER 2, 2020 Epidemiologic Week 45: 11/1/2020 - 11/7/2020



This report is based on only available data; not all results have been received.

San Benito County (SBC) Public Health Services continues to work with medical providers to identify and test individuals who meet criteria for COVID-19 testing. As of November 2, 2020, four new cases have been reported, for a total of 1,477 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in SBC. Confirmed cases include patients who have since recovered and those who are deceased. Fifty-three percent (783) of positive cases reported were female; ages ranged from 2 months to 101 years (median: 36 years).

All results included in this update are current to November 2, 2020 at 3:00PM.







GOAL: Less than 4 daily new cases (per 100k) for 2 consecutive weeks.


