
San Benito County (SBC) Public Health Services continues to work with medical providers to identify and test individuals who meet criteria for COVID-19 testing. As of November 17, 2020, twenty-three new cases have been reported, for a total of 1,643 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in SBC. Confirmed cases include patients who have since recovered and those who are deceased. Fifty-three percent (866) of positive cases reported were female; ages ranged from 29 days to 101 years (median: 36 years).

All results included in this update are current to November 17, 2020 at 3:45PM.



Onset of Symptoms




