
San Benito County (SBC) Public Health Services continues to work with medical providers to identify and test individuals who meet criteria for COVID-19 testing. As of November 18, 2020, nine new cases have been reported, for a total of 1,652 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in SBC. Confirmed cases include patients who have since recovered and those who are deceased. Fifty-three percent (873) of positive cases reported were female; ages ranged from 29 days to 101 years (median: 36 years).


