


## COVID-19 UPDATE: NOVEMBER 23, 2020







San Benito County (SBC) Public Health Services continues to work with medical providers to identify and test individuals who meet criteria for COVID-19 testing. As of November 23, 2020, five new cases have been reported, for a total of 1,746 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in SBC. Confirmed cases include patients who have since recovered and those who are deceased. Fifty-three percent (932) of positive cases reported were female; ages ranged from 29 days to 101 years (median: 36 years).





Person-to-person transmission occurs when infection is spread through a confirmed contact. Person-to-person transmission typically occurs in close-contact environments, such as households or workplaces.



Onset of Symptoms







# California Blueprint for a Safer Economy

### TIER 1: WIDESPREAD

- More than 7 daily new cases (per 100k).
- More than 8% positive tests.

### **TIER 2: SUBSTANTIAL**

- 4-7 daily new cases (per 100k).
- 5-8% positive tests.

#### TIER 3: MODERATE

- 1-3.9 daily new cases (per 100k).
- 2-4.9% positive tests.

### **TIER 4: MINIMAL**

- Less than 1 daily new cases (per 100k).
- Less than 2% positive tests.
