

San Benito County Public Health Services COVID-19 UPDATE: DECEMBER 1, 2020 Epidemiologic Week 49: 11/29/2020 - 12/5/2020



This report is based on only available data; not all results have been received.


San Benito County (SBC) Public Health Services continues to work with medical providers to identify and test individuals who meet criteria for COVID-19 testing. As of December 1, 2020, thirty-six new cases have been reported, for a total of 1,929 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in SBC. Confirmed cases include patients who have since recovered and those who are deceased. Fifty-four percent (1,036) of positive cases reported were female; ages ranged from 29 days to 101 years (median: 35 years).

All results included in this update are current to December 1, 2020 at 4:15PM.



Onset of Symptoms




