



COVID-19 UPDATE: DECEMBER 2, 2020








San Benito County (SBC) Public Health Services continues to work with medical providers to identify and test individuals who meet criteria for COVID-19 testing. As of December 2, 2020, thirty-nine new cases have been reported, for a total of 1,968 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in SBC. Confirmed cases include patients who have since recovered and those who are deceased. Fifty-four percent (1,058) of positive cases reported were female; ages ranged from 29 days to 101 years (median: 35 years).





California Blueprint for a Safer Economy

TIER 1: WIDESPREAD

- More than 7 daily new cases (per 100k).
- More than 8% positive tests.

TIER 2: SUBSTANTIAL

- 4-7 daily new cases (per 100k).
- 5-8% positive tests.

TIER 3: MODERATE

- 1-3.9 daily new cases (per 100k).
- 2-4.9% positive tests.

TIER 4: MINIMAL

- Less than 1 daily new cases (per 100k).
- Less than 2% positive tests.
