


## COVID-19 UPDATE: DECEMBER 3, 2020







San Benito County (SBC) Public Health Services continues to work with medical providers to identify and test individuals who meet criteria for COVID-19 testing. As of December 3, 2020, thirty-nine new cases have been reported, for a total of 2,007 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in SBC. Confirmed cases include patients who have since recovered and those who are deceased. Fifty-four percent (1,076) of positive cases reported were female; ages ranged from 29 days to 101 years (median: 35 years).





Onset of Symptoms




