

## San Benito County Public Health Services COVID-19 UPDATE: DECEMBER 9, 2020 Epidemiologic Week 50: 12/6/2020 - 12/12/2020




This report is based on only available data; not all results have been received.

San Benito County (SBC) Public Health Services continues to work with medical providers to identify and test individuals who meet criteria for COVID-19 testing. As of December 9, 2020, fifty new cases have been reported, for a total of 2,264 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in SBC. Confirmed cases include patients who have since recovered and those who are deceased. Fifty-three percent (1,212) of positive cases reported were female; ages ranged from 29 days to 101 years (median: 35 years).





Onset of Symptoms




