

## San Benito County Public Health Services COVID-19 UPDATE: DECEMBER 17, 2020 Epidemiologic Week 51: 12/13/2020 - 12/19/2020




This report is based on only available data; not all results have been received.

San Benito County (SBC) Public Health Services continues to work with medical providers to identify and test individuals who meet criteria for COVID-19 testing. As of December 17, 2020, forty-five new cases have been reported, for a total of 2,687 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in SBC. Confirmed cases include patients who have since recovered and those who are deceased. Fifty-three percent (1,434) of positive cases reported were female; ages ranged from 29 days to 101 years (median: 36 years).










GOAL: Less than 5% testing positive for 2 consecutive weeks.
