

## San Benito County Public Health Services COVID-19 UPDATE: DECEMBER 29, 2020 Epidemiologic Week 53: 12/27/2020 - 1/2/2021




This report is based on only available data; not all results have been received.

San Benito County (SBC) Public Health Services continues to work with medical providers to identify and test individuals who meet criteria for COVID-19 testing. As of December 28, 2020, fifty-eight new cases have been reported, for a total of 3,489 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in SBC. Confirmed cases include patients who have since recovered and those who are deceased. Fifty-three percent (1,844) of positive cases reported were female; ages ranged from 29 days to 101 years (median: 35 years).





Date of Test




