



COVID-19 Vaccine Schedule

COVID-19 vaccines will be distributed within San Benito County through the local health care system, including Public Health. At this time, vaccine supplies are limited, and it is uncertain when vaccines will be available. Phase and Tiers may change at any time based on recommendations by the CDC and California Department of Public Health.

Depending on vaccine production and how quickly other vaccines become available the best estimate of when the general public, who are not otherwise in Phase 1, could receive the vaccine would be Spring 2021, but that may change.
