



## COVID-19 Related Deaths in SBC by Race/Ethnicity






The data in this report displays information on demographics of COVID-19 related deaths and severe cases, including age, gender, race/ethnicity, and underlying health conditions. Providing detailed demographic breakdowns enables local health jurisdictions to determine appropriate actions to better prevent, control, and slow the spread of COVID-19. Deaths considered COVID-19 related are based on cause of death listed on the death certificate. The most recent deaths reported were two 70-year old adults, a female and a male, with two and one underlying health conditions, respectively.
