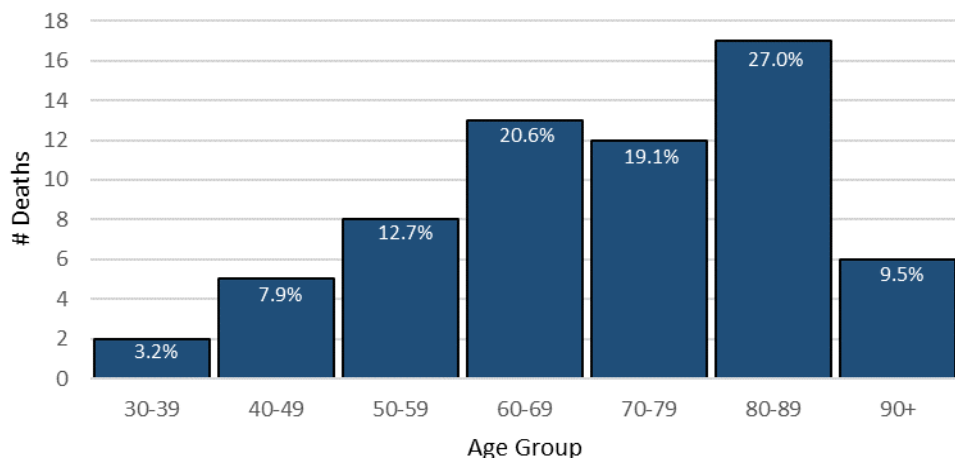

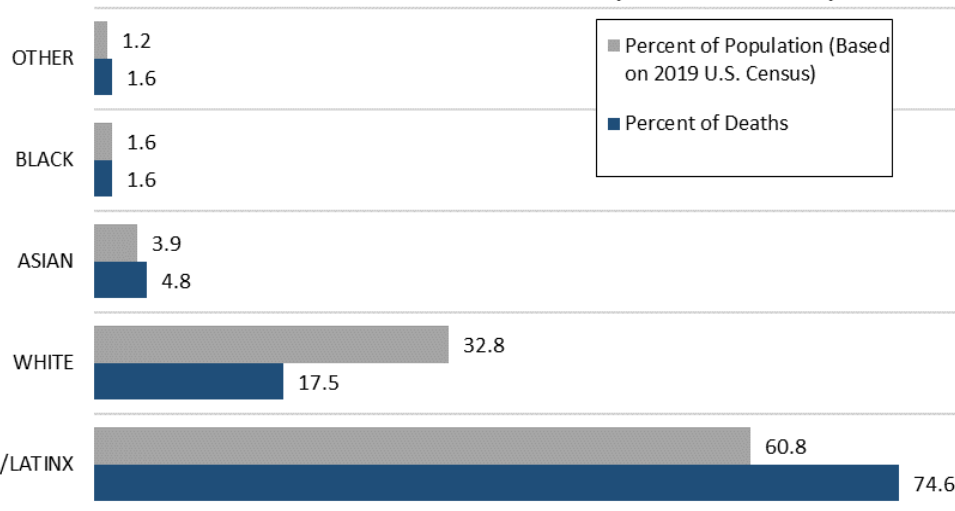
COVID-19 Related Deaths by Age Group



The data in this report displays information on demographics of COVID-19 related deaths and severe cases, including age, gender, race/ethnicity, and underlying health conditions. Providing detailed demographic breakdowns enables local health jurisdictions to determine appropriate actions to better prevent, control, and slow the spread of COVID-19. Deaths considered COVID-19 related are based on cause of death listed on the death certificate. The most recent death reported was a 68-year old female, with three underlying health conditions.

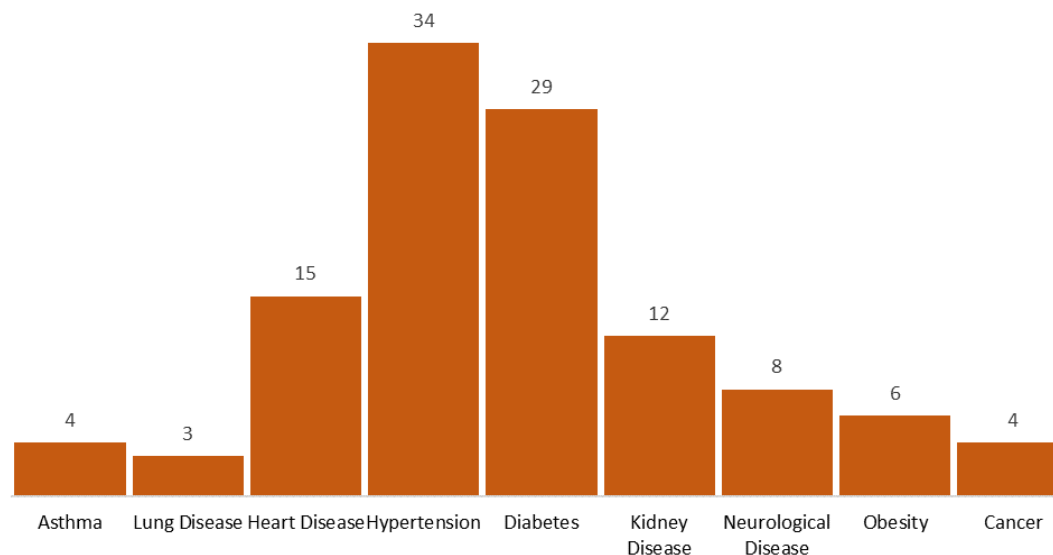
COVID-19 Related Deaths in SBC by Race/Ethnicity
