


COVID-19 UPDATE: JUNE 9, 2021








Confirmed cases include patients who have since recovered and those who are deceased. Fifty-three percent (3,235) of positive cases reported were female; ages ranged from 15 days to 101 years (median: 35 years).

All results included in this update are current to June 9, 2021 at 4:00PM.




