



## San Benito County Public Health Services

### COVID-19 UPDATE: JUNE 17, 2021







San Benito County (SBC) Public Health Services continues to work with medical providers to identify and test individuals who meet criteria for COVID-19 testing. As of June 17, 2021, five new cases have been reported, for a total of 6,109 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in SBC. Confirmed cases include patients who have since recovered and those who are deceased. Fifty-three percent (3,246) of positive cases reported

Confirmed cases include patients who have since recovered and those who are deceased. Fifty-three percent (3,246) of positive cases reported were female; ages ranged from 15 days to 101 years (median: 35 years).




SBC Cases Likely Source of Exposure

Community transmission occurs when the source of infection is unknown.


Person-to-person transmission occurs when infection is spread through a confirmed contact. Person-to-person transmission typically occurs in close-contact environments, such as households or workplaces.







#### SBC COVID-19 Cases by Age Group




