BASIC EMERGENCY NEEDS AND SUPPLIES

- ✓ Emergency blanket
- ✓ Map(s) of the local area
- ✓ Manual can opener
- ✓ Water — 1 gallon per person, per day (3-day supply for evacuation & 2-week supply for home)
- ✓ Food - Include foods that do not need cooking (3-day supply for evacuation & 2-week supply for home)
- ✓ Flashlight with extra batteries and bulbs (do not use candles)
- ✓ Battery-operated or hand-crank radio
- ✓ Medications (7-day supply) and medical items
- ✓ Multi-purpose tool (several tools that fold up into a pocket-sized unit)
- ✓ Sanitation and personal hygiene items (toilet paper, plastic garbage bags)
- ✓ Copies of personal documents (medication list and pertinent medical information, deed/lease to home, birth certificates, insurance policies)
- ✓ Cell phone with an extra battery and charger(s)
- ✓ Family and friends' emergency contact information
- ✓ Cash and coins (ATMs may not be accessible)
- ✓ Whistle (to attract the attention of emergency personnel)
- ✓ Pet supplies (including food and vaccination records)
- ✓ Extra set of keys (car, house, etc.)
- ✓ Pack of cards to provide entertainment and pass the time
- ✓ One change of clothing
- ✓ First aid kit and manual

COLD CLIMATE EMERGENCY SUPPLIES

It is possible that you will not have heat during or after a disaster. Think about your clothing and bedding needs. Be sure to include one set of the following for each person:

- ✓ Jacket or coat
- ✓ Long pants and long-sleeve shirt
- ✓ Sturdy shoes
- ✓ Hat, mittens and scarf
- ✓ Sleeping bag or warm blanket

SUPPLIES FOR YOUR VEHICLE

- ✓ Bottled water
- ✓ Maps
- ✓ First aid kit and manual
- ✓ Flashlight with extra batteries and extra bulbs
- ✓ Non-perishable foods such as granola bars
- ✓ Winter: Blanket, hat, mittens, shovel, sand, tire chains, windshield scraper, distress flag
- ✓ Summer: Sunscreen lotion SPF 15 or higher, shade item (umbrella, wide-brimmed hat, etc.)
- ✓ Tire repair kit
- ✓ Jumper cables
- ✓ Flares
