### Nail Salons Can Open Indoors with Modifications

**Sacramento, CA – September 22, 2020:** Governor Newsom announced today that California has revised the criteria for Nail Salons. The new revised criteria allows for Nail Salons to open **indoors** with modifications in counties listed as widespread risk level (purple tier), like San Benito County.

Nail Salons must follow this [guidance for personal care services](#) to create a safer environment for workers and patrons. Review the guidance, prepare a plan, and post the [checklist for personal care services](#) in your workplace to show customers and employees that you've reduced the risk and are open for business.

Additionally wearing a [mask or face covering](#) is required statewide in public or common spaces. Employers must provide face coverings to workers or must reimburse workers for the reasonable cost of obtaining them.
